Our Easter event this year is being held at Greatstone Primary School in Kent. Greatstone village is on the East coast of Romney Marsh, between Folkestone and Rye, about one mile from the Cinque port of New Romney known for its fine safe sandy beach. Prior to the 1920s there was hardly anything to Greatstone at all. In the 1920s the area was predominantly covered by sand dunes and consisted of just a few properties mainly used as holiday homes. There was however widespread development in the 1960s and 1970s, leading to the sizable community it is today. Check out (Google) the Sound Mirrors at Greatstone.

Turn left at Sainsburys onto Littlestone Road then right at the seafront onto Grand Parade. Continue for a quarter of a mile and turn right into Baldwin Road where the school is at the end. Look for SLC signs towards the school.
